1. INTRODUCTION

The aim of this document is to provide instruction on the usage of the QuizMaster Application for a non-experienced user.

QuizMaster is an XML application which allows a user to participate in multiple choice style quizzes on their OpenStage 60/80 IP Phone. The questions and answers are picked from a database at random for each topic. Topics and questions can be added, edited and deleted by an administrator via a web portal.

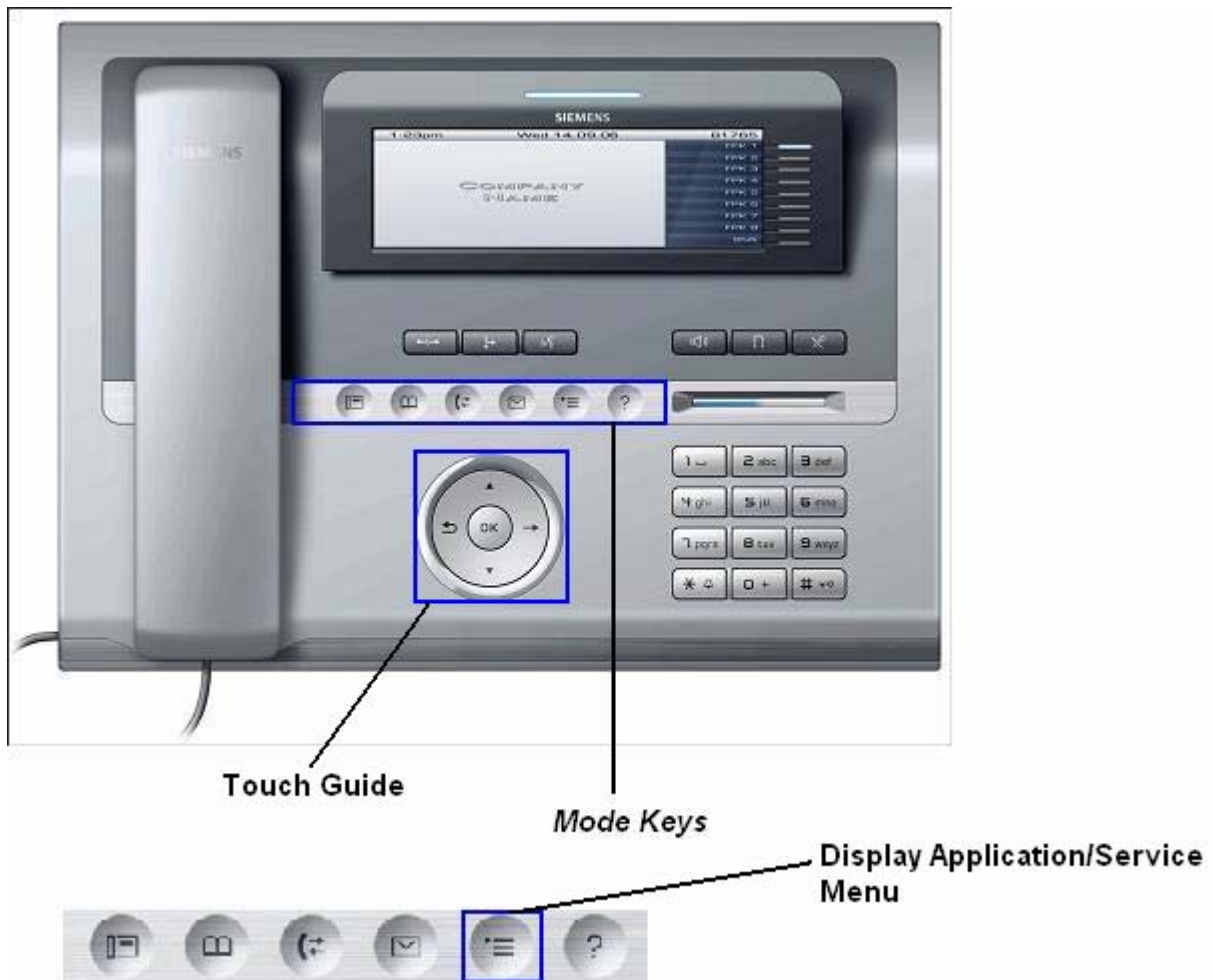
2. SCOPE

This guide is intended primarily for users of OpenStage 60/80 IP Phones.

System installation instructions are not covered in this user guide. Please see the document "QuizMaster_Installation_Guide.doc" for information on deploying and configuring QuizMaster on your XML Application Server.

3. STARTING QUIZMASTER

The image below shows an OpenStage phone.



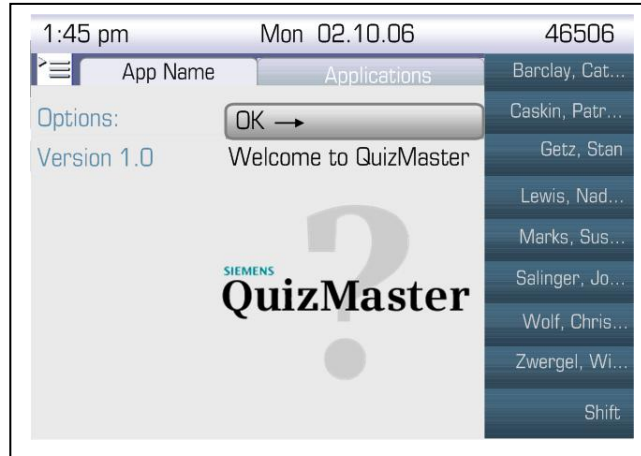
Pressing the **Display Application/Service Menu** mode key takes the user to application mode.

Press this key to cycle through the applications screens until the **Applications** tab is highlighted.

Use the touch guide to scroll through entries, select QuizMaster from the applications menu and press **OK**.

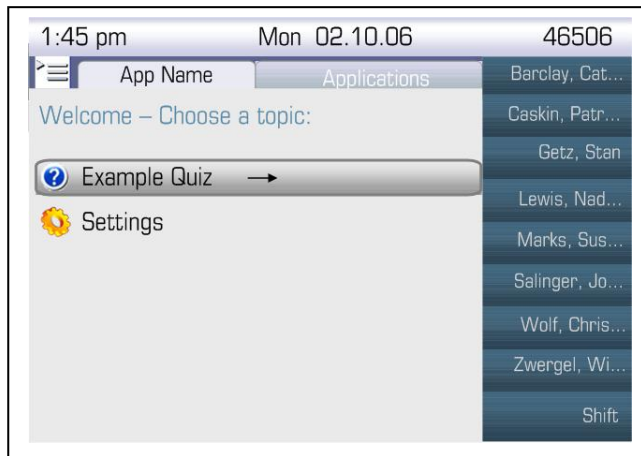
4. USING QUIZMASTER

4.1 Splash Screen



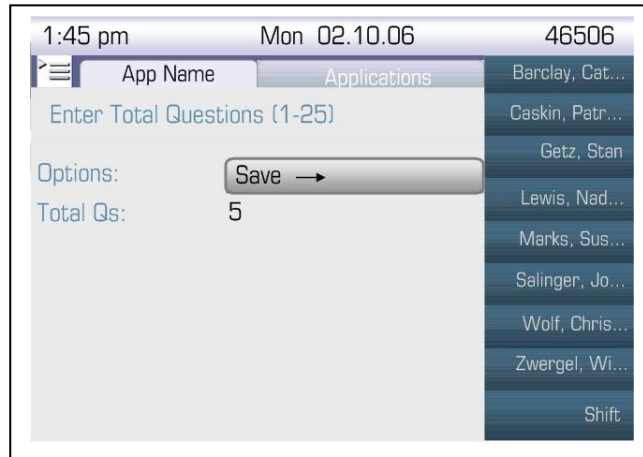
The first screen displayed when running the application is a title page displaying the current application version. Click OK to continue to the main menu.

4.2 Main Menu



The Main Menu screen displays the current list of quiz topics available. Clicking on a topic name will start that particular quiz. Clicking on Settings will take you to the Settings Menu.

4.3 Settings Menu

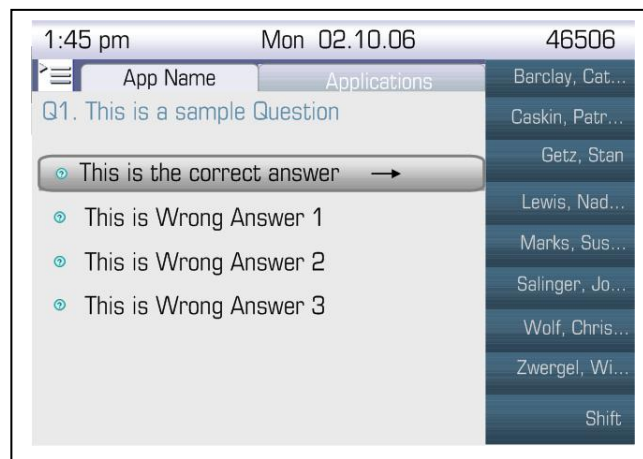


The settings menu allows you to change the number of questions in each quiz. By default the value is 5.

Clicking on the number will allow you to enter in a new value. Enter a number and click **OK** to return to the Settings menu, then click **Save** to save your entry. A confirmation will be displayed.

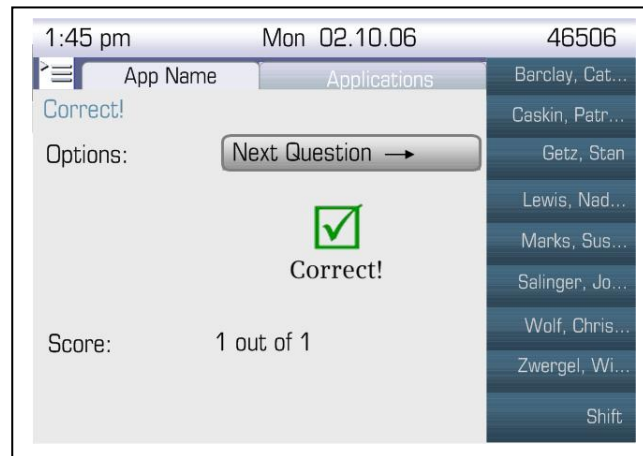
4.4 Question Screen

Clicking on a quiz topic will take you to the first question.



Using the touch guide scroll through the answers and select the answer you think to be correct.

4.5 Answer Screen



After answering a question you will be presented with the answer screen. Here you will be told if your answer was correct or incorrect. If your answer was wrong, you will be told what the correct answer was. At the bottom of the screen you can view your running total score (number of correct answers against the number of questions answered so far).

To go to the next question click the **Next Question** button.

4.6 Final Score



The final score will display how many questions you scored correctly out of the total number asked. To go back to the main menu select **Choose another topic**.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section lists the typical issues you may encounter with the QuizMaster Application.

5.1 QuizMaster Application FAQ

Q. There are no topics to select on the Main Menu

A. The quiz database may be empty or the server may not be able to locate the database. Please contact your server administrator.

Q. I receive an error message: Error reading information from the Server for this Application

A. Make sure that the server is running. You may need to restart the application for any changes to take effect.

Q. I keep being sent back to the Main Menu in the middle of a quiz

A. Make sure you do not double click the **OK** button or click too quickly as this can cause the application to reset back to the Main Menu.

Q. I get the error message: Quiz does not contain enough questions

A. The total number of questions specified in the settings menu needs to be the same size or less than the number of questions in the database for your chosen topic. Go to the settings menu and choose a smaller number.
